You can make a referral for your son/daughter to:

 Counselling – we have a counsellor in Primary (Kylie) and Post Primary (Orla) who will do lots of practical activities to address a wide range of issues for example: friendships, sibling rivalry, acceptance of disability, anxiety.

Music Therapy – Conor our music therapist is with us weekly and can help to address a wide range of issues particularly using music to give a method of expression.
